

Mini Museum Challenge

Contest Brief

The National Heritage Board and its Heritage Institutions are calling all children aged 12 and below residing in Singapore to create your own mini museum at home. Simply feature <u>3 - 5 objects from your home</u> and take a video (not more than 2 minutes) of you providing a guided tour of your mini museum. Tell us why these objects are important to you and your family, and submit it to us to receive attractive prizes. This contest is open from <u>18 Nov 2020 to 18 Dec 2020</u>.

You may choose to participate in the following categories:

Participants will stand to win the following prizes:

All participants will also receive a goodie bag redeemable at our three Heritage Institutions (Indian Heritage Centre, Malay Heritage Centre and Sun Yat Sen Nanyang Memorial Hall). The winning entries will be featured on our social media platforms.

Guidelines and Tips for the Contest

Ready to start? You can consider the following themes (or create your own theme):

- My Mini Museum of Treasures (e.g. photographs, mementos, heirlooms, presents from loved ones etc.)
- My Mini Food Museum (e.g. favorite food, utensils, ingredients, recipes etc.)
- My Mini Museum of Festivals (e.g. festive attire, items used during festivals, festive decorations, photographs etc.)
- My Mini Games/Toys Museum (e.g. 'goli', 'captek', hantam bola, five stones, game sets, toys etc.)

You may also wish to consider the following structure when creating your video:

Instructions:

- 1. Print out the contest form.
- 2. Choose a theme for your mini museum.
- 3. Consider the objects that you would like to feature in your mini museum, and ensure that you have at least 3 5 objects.
- 4. Think of a storyline to best present your objects.
- 5. Prepare a script to present your mini-museum to be video-taped.
- 6. Ask your parents/older siblings for help to take a video (camera/phone) of you giving a guided tour of your mini museum.
- 7. All videos must be taken in <u>landscape format</u>, and <u>cannot be longer than 2 minutes</u>.
- 8. Complete the contest form and submit the signed contest form along with the video to us before 2359 hours on 18 Dec 2020.
- All files must be saved in the following format: child's name_child's surname_child's age.mp4 (e.g. Charlotte_Ng_7.mp4).
- 10. The video must be sent as a single, hi-res file to us.
- 11. Note that all special effects or editing done to the video will not be considered for judging.

Entry Requirements

- 1. This contest is open to all Singaporeans, PRs, as well as foreign families residing in Singapore.
- 2. Participants intending to participate in this contest must have the consent of their parent or guardian to do so. Parental or guardian consent will be given by signing on the contest form.
- 3. By permitting their child to enter this contest, parents/guardians acknowledge that they have read, understood, and agreed to be bound by these terms and conditions.
- 4. Only <u>one entry</u> may be submitted by each participant. Video submitted must be the participant's own original work. Participants are to ensure that submitted entries do not infringe any intellectual property rights of third parties. Participants are not allowed to submit the same video for different categories for the contest.
- 5. Participants are to comply with the guidelines stated at <u>https://www.nhb.gov.sg/what-we-do/our-work/community-engagement/education/resources/national-symbols/</u> if their designs feature National Symbols (National Flag of Singapore, Lion Head Symbol, etc).
- 6. All valid entries must be submitted during the specific contest period (18 Nov to 18 Dec 2020). Entries submitted after 2359 on 18 Dec 2020 will not be accepted.
- 7. Entries submitted which do not meet the requirements under these Terms and Conditions will be invalid and will automatically be disqualified. NHB reserves the right to select an alternative winner if NHB has reasonable grounds for believing that a winner has contravened any of the Terms and Conditions.

Note: Staff of the National Heritage Board (including staff of the Heritage Institutions) and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter this contest.

Winning Entries

- 8. NHB will notify the participant and/or parent/guardian that his or her winning video has been selected to be posted on our Facebook pages prior to posting.
- 9. All decisions by NHB are final and no appeals nor further correspondence concerning the decision to award to the contest winners will be entertained.
- 10. All prize(s) are as stated and are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged. No cash or credit alternatives will be offered. In the event and due to circumstances beyond NHB's control, that NHB is unable to provide the stated prize(s), NHB reserves the right to award, as substitute, a prize of equal or higher value.
- 11. Collection of prizes must be done in person/by parent/guardian with valid proof of identification (NRIC/Passport/Student pass).
- 12. The identity of the winners will be published during the announcement of winning entries. By taking part in this contest, the participants with the winning entries acknowledge and agree that their names will be made available to the public.
